Enclosed are Team and Sponsor Team Application Forms for the 2022 Jackson Hole One Fly, information on the Team Selection Process, and a 2021 One Fly Program Book. If you wish to apply and be considered for selection, please complete the appropriate application and return it to us with your deposit check of \$3,800 (\$6,300 for sponsor team) by *no later than December 15, 2021*.

Total Team Entry Fee is \$7,600 for a four-person team; \$12,600 for a four-person Sponsor Team.

- Fee for any Alternates is \$400 per Alternate. Each team may have up to four Alternates.
- Each team may include only one professional fly fisher (active guide).
- Spouses and friends are also welcome and guest tickets may be purchased for all social events at the cost of \$250 per person. Seating is limited, please reserve tickets early.

The Team Selection Process begins in December, and you will be notified by January 15, 2022 if your team has been selected or if your team is on the Alternate Team List. After you have received this notification, you are considered a <u>Committed Selected Team</u> or a <u>Committed Alternate Team</u>. If you wish to withdraw after receiving selection notification, you must do so in writing by <u>no later than February 15, 2022</u> and your deposit will be returned to you.

The balance of the team fee (\$3,800 for non-sponsors/\$6300 for sponsors, plus \$400 for each Alternate) is due **no later than April 1, 2022.** Any Committed Selected Team that fails to pay their balance by April 1, 2022 will forfeit their deposit and will be replaced by a Committed Alternate Team.

Deposits of Committed Alternate Teams that are not selected for the event will be returned as soon as possible after the April 1, 2022 balance-due deadline.

The 2022 Jackson Hole One Fly Event will include:

- 1.) Registration and Cocktail Party the evening of September 8th. Participants receive their Information Packet which includes pin, patch, shirt, as well as fishing venues, guides and boat mates.
- 2.) Banquet Dinner and Auction the evening of September 9th.
- 3.) Western Barbecue and Award Presentations the evening of September 11th after fishing.
- 4.) Breakfast, Lunch and Guided Fishing during the competition on September 10th and 11th.

The emphasis of this unique, nationally recognized Event is to celebrate fly fishing and raise funds for stream improvement projects. You will meet, fish, and become friends with fly fishing enthusiasts from around the world while contributing to the important conservation of our fisheries.
