Dear 2026 Jackson Hole One Fly Team Applicant:

As we look forward to the 2026 Jackson Hole One Fly, I'd like to once again thank you for your support in helping us host a very successful 2025 One Fly event. We are very appreciative of the great energy and resources provided by our participants which allows us to draw attention to the world class resource that is the Snake River, both the main stem in Wyoming and the South Fork across the border in Idaho. In drawing attention (and fishermen) to these waters, our hope is that we can raise awareness and funds to protect the rivers and the fish for current and future generations. Your participation and generous donations are instrumental to our cause.

In order to continue to improve the quality of the One Fly experience and ensure our fundraising capability remains strong, we have three points we need to highlight with this letter. The first is that we are asking potential new Sponsor teams to confirm where noted on their application that they are willing to sign up to at least a 3 year financial commitment (currently \$20,000) to remain at the Sponsor level. Please note that admission of new Sponsor teams is not guaranteed, but subject to demand and availability. The second is to highlight a rule change that we will be implementing which involves leader length. Starting with the 2026 event, all leaders will now be limited to 18 feet total length from the connection with the fly line to the connection with the fly itself. This 18 foot leader length can be a fully floating leader or a 7 foot (max) sink tip attached to a floating leader of no more than 11 additional feet in length (again 18 foot total leader length). The third point we want to highlight is a simple request that all teams that plan to participate in the Pro division should specify the person on their team who meets the definition of a Pro as noted on our website.

We look forward to seeing you for the 2026 Jackson Hole One Fly. Your participation and support will add to the legacy of what we believe is the oldest and best cold water fly fishing tournament in North America.
